

Registration Number Required for Ag Tax Exemptions

To meet the requirements of House Bill 268, passed during the 82nd Legislature Regular Session (2011), Cooke County Electric Cooperative Association requires that beginning Jan. 1, 2012 a person claiming an exemption from sales tax for agricultural purposes must provide a registration number issued by the Comptroller of Public Accounts on the sales and use tax exemption certificate issued to CCECA.

The Comptroller of Public Account office has launched an online application for the registration numbers. Agriculture producers that apply online can get their numbers on the spot. Accounts of members who have not provided Cooke County Electric Cooperative Association with an updated sales tax exemption certificate, including their registration number, will be considered taxable effective January 1, 2012.
